ANNUAL INDUCTION CEREMONY

The New Hampshire Legends of Hockey Board of Directors and Co-Master of Ceremonies Ken Cail and Chris Garrett, inducted six new members into the New Hampshire Hockey Hall of Fame class of 2018, in front of a crowd of more than 250 family members, friends, dignitaries and guests.

The Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony & Luncheon was held on October 21, 2018 at the Grappone Conference Center in Concord.

It marked the NH Legends' seventeenth year hosting the event and the Legends also paid tribute to Manchester Regional Youth Hockey Association (MRYHA).

Inducted into the 2018 Hall of Fame Class were Brendan Creagh of Hanover, Brian Foster of Pembroke and Rich Ryerson of Concord as players. Dartmouth College coach Bob Gaudet as a coach. Don McKinnon as an official and the late Anthony "Tony" Urban was inducted posthumously as a builder.

At next year's ceremony, the Legends will pay tribute to the Alpine Club of the early 60's. Submission of nomination forms for individuals may be electronically submitted between January 1 and February 28.

ALL-STATE RECIPIENTS AND SENIOR ALL-STAR CLASSIC

For the eighth straight year, the Legends partnered with the NH High School Coaches Association (NHHSC) to help support New Hampshire high school hockey. NHHSC is comprised of high school coaches from across the State. Each year they select the best high school seniors from the Boys Divisions I and II as well as the best from DIII. The DI and II game features the teams wearing the Legends jerseys. This year's games are scheduled for **Sunday March 16, 2019 at noon and 12:15 pm** at the Rinks at Exeter and is open to the public. Those jerseys are also used in the annual Make-A-Wish hockey games for both the boys and girls against VT each summer. Last summer the NH Boy's team lost 2-1 while the Girl's won 4-2. For the seventh straight year, the Legends partnered with the NH Prep School Coaches. The coaches selected their All-State Teams for the boys and girls divisions. The eight prep schools in New Hampshire are Brewster Academy; Holderness School; Kimball Union Academy; New Hampton School; Phillips Exeter Academy; Proctor Academy; St. Paul's School and Tilton School.

The Legends provided certificates for all the NH High School and Prep School All-State players.
